



Freeport Tuna Club Discussion Boards User Registration Instructions

Members and non-members of the Freeport Tuna Club are welcome to view our forums. If you'd like to participate in the forum discussions you must register and create a user account. A few of our forums are restricted to Freeport Tuna Club members. FTC members can request access to the restricted forums by email. Access will be granted once membership status has been verified. The following steps will help guide you through the registration process. If you have any questions or problems, contact the forum administrator at ftcforumadmin@ftcfishing.com.

Step 1: Register and create a user account

1. Go to the FTC Discussion Board by clicking on the "Forum" navigation button from the www.ftcfishing.com home page or by going to <http://www.ftcfishing.com/phpbb>
2. To create a user account click on the "Register" link which is located at the top of the page under the Freeport Tuna Club Discussion Boards banner.
3. Follow the registration instructions.
4. You will receive an activation email. You must click on the link in the activation email to complete the registration process. If you don't receive an activation email (and you can't find it in your Junk or Spam email folders) contact the forum administrator at ftcforumadmin@ftcfishing.com for activation.

Step 2: Request access to the members-only forums (FTC members-only)

1. Send an email to ftcforumadmin@ftcfishing.com with the Subject "Request access to members-only forums". Include your forum **username** and your **full name** in the email.
2. The administrator will send you an email when access has been granted. Please keep in mind that this is a manual process and make take a day or two.

Note: Access will only be granted to FTC members in good standing.

Step 3: Participate
